Dear Friends,

I am writing this email to inform that my family is saved by God's grace and through your prayers from the recent devastating earthquake and from the war/conflict that erupted in the heart of my village in the second week of March 2025. In spite of all the turmoil and troubles around us, our family is doing well, our church and school ministry continues though our school was shut down for a week due to the war.

In the second week of March, to be specific, on March 8, 2025, the conflict reached my village where a young man was shot death in the fight against the enemies and evil forces. Just before the fights broke out on 8th March, sensing difficult situations ahead, I took my wife and children and fled to Shillong again. God protected us and we are all safe. Then, after a week as situations gets better, I returned to our home in Manipur, and I left my wife and children in Shillong for their safety and children's education.

Two weeks later, the government took away large portions of our land forcefully for highway expansion works without giving any compensation or rehabilitation works in place and even pulled down our house. Hoinu and I are deeply sad for this. But, we trust that God knows what is best for us. We will go through this also in God's strength.

Please continue to pray for some of our urgent and pressing needs.

1. To built at least two rooms for our family (one for kitchen and one for us to stay).
2. To make a retaining wall on the river side before the monsoon comes this year.
3. To be able to repair the remaining 5 classrooms before the education officials comes for inspections.
4. For our family needs in Shillong
